* What do Simon and his cat do every day ?

Simon's cat **tries** (to try) to wake Simon up at 6.46 a.m.



Simon **has** (to have) breakfast at 6.59 a.m. Every morning his cat **eats** (to eat) breakfast on his head.

Simon **has** (to have) a shower every day at 7.20 a.m. He **sings** (to sing) every morning. His cat only **wants** (to want) to eat.

In the morning, Simon's cat **drinks** (to drink) water from the toilet.

He also **eats** (to eat) the toothbrushes.



Simon usually **works** (to work) on his computer at 8.57 a.m.

His cat **doesn't want** (not / to want) him to work !!!

Simon **cleans** (to clean) the kitchen at 11.55 a.m.



Simon **has** (to have) lunch at 1 p.m. He often **gives** (to give) his cat his pizza.

Simon **makes** (to make) his bed every evening at 7.05 p.m.



At 8.05 p.m., Simon **watches** (to watch) TV.

His cat finally **switches off** (to switch off) the TV.

At the end of the day Simon **is** (to be) tired. He **goes** (to go) to bed every day at 10 p.m.



What a tiring day for Simon ! His cat **does** (to do) silly things all the time !!!
